
FRIENDS OF KNOCKLOFTY BUSHCARE

Transforming the city-fringed bushland of Knocklofty Reserve from a once-degraded state into a biologically diverse place.

- Mar 6*General weed control, Weerona Trail, KR7.Meet: End of Bimbadeen Crt, West Hobart.
- Mar 20 Forget-me-not and thistle control in Providence Rivulet Gully, KR14. Meet: End of Bimbadeen Crt, West Hobart.
- Apr 3* Sandy Spit Track general weeding both sides of Salvator Rosa Glen KR18. Meet: Forest Rd car park, Knocklofty Reserve, West Hobart.
- Apr 17 Roving control and mapping of Spanish heath near the summit, KR12 and 18. Meet: Forest Rd car park, Knocklofty Reserve, West Hobart.

at end of the fire trail (wear long/strong
sleeves). Steep slopes good fitness and
balance required.Meet: Fuel break below 7 Beddome St

driveway. Bicentennial Park.
