BY-LAW No. 5 of 2018

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

- 1. This by-law is made pursuant to section 145 of the Act for the purpose of setting penalties for parking pursuant to the Highways Act in the Council's municipal area.
- 2. This by-law may be cited as the Parking By-law.
- 3. The Car Parks & Parking By-law No. 2 of 2008 is repealed.
- 4. This by-law applies to the Hobart municipal area.
- 5. In this by-law:

Highways Act means the Local Government (Highways) Act 1982.

PART 2 – HIGHWAYS ACT

Amounts payable

6. For the purposes of section 100(4) of the Highways Act, the prescribed penalty for an infringement notice issued for an offence under section 97, 98 or 99 of the Highways Act is the applicable sum specified adjacent to the offence in the following table:
